



## GOLDFIELDS JUNIOR TRAVEL GROUP

### INVITATION/TOURNAMENT PACKAGE

On behalf of the Goldfields Golf Club in conjunction with GolfWA, you are invited to take part in the **2019 Goldfields Junior Desert Open** over 36 holes on the highly regarded Kalgoorlie Golf Course in Kalgoorlie WA. The '**Goldfields Team Challenge**' will continue again across the stroke event, with junior representing their clubs in competition against one another through their two best gross and nett scores each round.

We are offering an exclusive tournament package to participants which includes transportation, accommodation, some meals and entry fees for the event. Open to all junior golfers aged 12 – 18 years. The group size is capped at 20 golfers and 4 parents

#### Dates:

- Friday September 27 – Golf Clubs/Travel bag dropped at GolfWA for Freight transit
- Monday September 30 – Depart East Perth Station at 7am, arrive in Kalgoorlie at 3pm
- Tuesday October 1<sup>st</sup> – Round 1 of Goldfields Junior Desert Open
- Wednesday October 2<sup>nd</sup> – Round 2 of Goldfields Junior Desert Open and Presentations
- Thursday October 3<sup>rd</sup> – Depart Kalgoorlie at 7am, arrive in East Perth at 3:30pm

#### The total fee includes:

- Return Train Ticket on the Prospector (East Perth to Kalgoorlie)
- Bus Transfers within Kalgoorlie
- Golf Club Freight Transport
- 3 Nights' Accommodation at Fairbridge Kalgoorlie Camp

#### Volunteer Parent Chaperones Required:

- GolfWA requires the assistance of Voluntary Chaperones, ideally by parents of children travelling as part of the group.
- **Voluntary Chaperones will not be charged** to attend and receive the above package FOC.
- **Working With Children Check (WWCC) required** – If parent does not have valid WWCC, GolfWA will cover costs and coordinate application for a WWCC

### Tournament Information

The event is a 36-Hole stroke play tournament with prizes awarded across the various age groups. There will be gross and nett winners, with a boys and girls GJDO Champion alongside the newly introduced club junior team's event. The Champion Boy and Girl will earn a spot in the Road to the Outback Challenge, played in Kalgoorlie during the TX Civil Logistics WA PGA Championship on Saturday and Sunday October 12 and 13. Amateur players are drawn with a professional and play alongside them in an aggregate stableford event.

- Breakfast will be provided on Tuesday (1<sup>st</sup>) and Wednesday (2<sup>nd</sup>) with a packed breakfast provided for the train trip back on Thursday morning (3<sup>rd</sup>)
- Lunch is available for purchase during travel on train, and at golf club during/after rounds

### Expenses:

Transport, accommodation and stated meals are provided. All other expenses are NOT covered as part of the tournament package. Additional purchases including travel lunches (Monday and Thursday), range balls, snacks and drinks are at own cost.

Registrations close **Friday August 30<sup>th</sup> 2019** to aid with accommodation and transport bookings. Metropolitan and Regional Golf Clubs are encouraged to participate and support at least **two junior golfers** to represent their club in the Goldfields Teams Challenge. Maximum 20 players, 4 parents
